

2023 Student of the Year Application

Due Friday, March 10, 2023

The Public Relations Association of Mississippi (PRAM) is comprised of more than 500 public relations professionals from advertising and public relations agencies, corporations, non-profit organizations, government, education, industries and other companies.

PRAM is a source of expertise and continuing education, and a forum for networking with public relations practitioners throughout the state and region. The organization is composed of 9 local chapters and is a member organization of the Southern Public Relations Federation (SPRF).

The Student of the Year award is bestowed to one student annually who exemplifies the professionalism, goals, and ideals of the public relations profession.

The Student of the Year winner will be announced at the annual PRAM Conference in April.

Student of the Year Award nominee receives:

- Chance of winning a \$1,000 scholarship and the Student of the Year Award
- Recognition at the awards program held during the PRAM state conference, including presentation of Certificate of Achievement
- Photo with PRAM Officers and nominating professor, along with a press release sent to newspaper of student's choice
- Chance to be posted on the PRAM website
- Reference letter from PRAM President
- Opportunity to network with PRAM professional members at annual conference

Nominating professor/instructor receives:

- Opportunity to register for the 2023 PRAM state conference at the early registration rate
- A chance to obtain a 2023 free membership to the PRAM chapter of choice for the professor/instructor who nominates the Student of the Year Award winner
- Recognition at the awards program held during the PRAM state conference
- Invitation to place university/college materials in the following year's conference bag
- Recognition letter from the PRAM President sent to university/college president expressing PRAM's gratitude and appreciation for professor/instructor's contribution to the public relations profession

Scoring:

Each applicant's score is based on the following criteria in order of importance:

- 60% academic excellence and academic honors along with public relations activities and experience
- 30% campus involvement plus community activities
- 10% articulation of future goals and a letter of recommendation from the student's nominating professor/instructor

Student Eligibility:

Students eligible for the award must meet the following requirements:

- Must be an undergraduate at a Mississippi university or college that offers at least one course with the words 'public relations' in the course title
- Must be a full-time student
- Must have completed at least one course with the words 'public relations' in the title by the end of December of the year they are nominated
- Must be a public relations, communication, journalism, or marketing communications major
- A student who has already received the Student of the Year Award is not eligible to be nominated for the award again.

University/College Eligibility: Any university or college offering at least one course with the words 'public relations' in the course title.

Professors/Instructors Eligibility: Educators who teach at least one course with the words 'public relations' in the title at an eligible university or college may participate. Only one nominee will be accepted annually from each eligible nominating professor/instructors. However, each eligible university/college may have more than one student nominee.

Nomination Requirements: The following must be completed to apply:

- Application (page 3-4 of this document) completed by the student and signed by the nominating professor/instructors. Additional sheets or a resume may be attached if needed.
- 2. **Letter of recommendation** from the student's nominating professor/instructors. This letter should be no more than one page on university/college letterhead.
- 3. **Student's college transcript.** An unofficial transcript (PDF) should be sent via email to Samantha McCain, APR VP of Student Services at mccainsam@gmail.com.
- 4. Nominee must be able to attend the PRAM State Conference. He/she must agree to attend at least one day of the PRAM State Conference or forfeit all nominee benefits and the chance to compete for the Student of the Year Award and scholarship. Conference registration information can be found at www.pramonline.org.
- 5. DEADLINE: Materials must be received no later than 11:59 p.m. on Friday, March 10, 2023

Judging and Notification:

- The Awards Committee will evaluate applications and will choose the Student of the Year winner from among the student nominees and will announce the winner at the PRAM Awards portion of the PRAM State Conference.
- Each nominee and nominating professor will be notified as soon as possible after receipt of application regarding conference registration in order to make arrangements for attending PRAM State Conference.
